I am writing you this letter to thank the loving patrons of the agronomic project (Moringa Project) that W.I.S.H. looks after in my town of Ansa a Galets on LaGonave Island in my country Haiti.

This project grows a good tree that is called Moringa. This tree is special because you can eat the young leaves. You can boil them and add salt and they are good food.

Or the leaves can be gathered and dried and then ground up into a powder. This powder has protein and other good things that keep people healthy.

I would like to sit with you and share a story about the powdered moringa that this project gives us, to help with a nutritious noon meal that we give the children. These children are very poor because they often do not get food every day. We use the dried (ground) moringa that you give us, to give the children health. We know that it is important to live a healthy life, so beginning in 2002 we begin to add the power to our rice and beans. Before we begin this, a lot of children have Tenia (no-translation - medical condition) in their heads and arms. I believe that it was the good stuff in the power that takes away the Tenia. We give thanks that God has blessed the children with better health.

We also thank you for giving the food program this good powder.
