*This week the library construction hit a milestone! We started setting the trusses for the roof. These were all welded months ago, but it took us a little time to find the plate steel for the support posts and get them built. This week we will set the last truss in place, and then do all of the cross bracing and start putting on roofing.*

*We also had the excitement of seeing Bena again. He has been out of the country for the past two months with an organization called Youth With A Mission. They did Discipleship Training School (DTS) in Port Au Prince for 4 months, and then they went to Africa for two months of missions service. On Monday morning he led the morning Bible study and preached to all of the WISH workers. It is great to see how excited he is about God and his walk with Him. Right now he is trying to find what all he can and should do for the people of Haiti. Pray for doors to open and Bena to have clear direction in what God wants him to do.*

*Okay, enjoy your Thanksgiving week if you are in the states. We are going to have a dinner with all of the North American Wesleyan Missionaries from Port Au Prince and LaGonave on Tuesday. I know it is a strange day to pick, but it worked with all of our schedules. There is a small team on the Wesleyan compound which decided to bring a turkey with them, so all of us are bringing side dishes and they are providing a bird. It should be fun.*
